Town of Spring Green, Sauk County, Wisconsin

RULES AND REGULATIONS

These Rules and Regulations, and ordinance Chapter 17, shall apply to the Spring Green Cemetery.

1. The Town Board may adopt rules and regulations for the management and care of the Cemetery and may enforce those rules and regulations under s. 157.II(2), Wis. Stats.
2. No person shall be present upon Cemetery property when the Cemetery is not open to the public. Cemetery property shall be officially open to the public between dawn and dusk on a daily basis.
3. Motor vehicles within the Cemetery may not exceed 15 miles per hour. No motor vehicle, except authorized maintenance vehicles for the Town, shall be driven except on drives and parking areas adjacent to the Cemetery.
4. Recreational or other amusement vehicles including, but not limited to, skateboards, roller skates, toboggans, go-carts, snowmobiles, all-terrain vehicles, are not allowed in the Cemetery.
5. Privately owned lawn mowers or power trimmers shall not be permitted on the Cemetery at any time.
6. No person shall have in his possession any firearm except peace officers and military attendants at funerals.
7. No person shall engage in violent, abusive, indecent, profane, boisterous, unreasonable loud or otherwise disorderly conduct under circumstances in which such conduct tends to cause or provoke a disturbance in the Cemetery.
8. No person under the age of ten years shall be allowed in the Cemetery unless accompanied by a parent, guardian or caretaker.
9. No pets shall be allowed in the Cemetery except service animals accompanying a person with sight impairment or other disability while in the Cemetery.
10. No person shall loiter or cause a nuisance on the Cemetery property.
11. No person shall litter, dump, or deposit any rubbish, earth, or other material in the Cemetery without the Town's consent
12. No person shall consume or have in his possession any alcoholic beverages while on the Cemetery property.
13. No glass containers are permitted in the Cemetery.
14. All rules, regulations and prices are subject to change at any time without notice.
15. All memorial items are to be placed entirely on the base of the marker. Any items placed that impede maintenance operations will be removed at the Town's discretion at any time. The exception to this rule is the Veteran's flags purchased by Sauk County and placed with Town's approval.
16. Cemetery clean-up will occur the first week of October and the first week prior to Easter on an annual basis. Landscaping on any gravesite will be removed. Deteriorated floral arrangements and any other items such as glass jars, bottles, toys, cans, memorabilia, personal items, and other similar objects will be removed at the Town's discretion.
