2.10 Intent. The intent of this chapter is to provide for public health, safety and welfare.

2.20 Speed Limits.

- (1) The speed limit on all unposted roads is 55 miles per hour as set forth in section 346.59(4)(h).
- (2) The speed limit on the following roads shall be 45 miles per hour:
 - (a) Jones Road.
 - (b) Kennedy Road from Pearl Road to Highway 130.
 - (c) Olson Road.
 - (d) Pearl Road from Highway 14 to Kennedy Road.
 - (e) Rainbow Road
- (3) The speed limit shall be 40 miles per hour on Kennedy Road from Shifflet Road to Pearl Road.
- (4) The speed limit on the following roads shall be 25 miles per hour:

Brace Road, Branch Trail, Carlos Road, Cedarberry Drive, Donald Road, East Donald Road, North Donald Road, South Donald Road, Earl Drive, Ellen Road, Florence Laudon Parkway, Flowage Road, Greenway Lane, Highbanks Road, Ivy Lane, Jennifer Lane, East Laudon Road, West Laudon Road, Leone Road, Martal Way, McKenna Road, Merrilee Road, Monument Road, Pearl Road (south of Kennedy Road), Phylane Road, Porter Road (south of Kennedy Road to STH 130), Richland Road, Riverside Drive, Rolling Ridge Road, Ruetten Drive, Sauter Road, Sherwood Drive, Shifflet Road, Spruce Trail, Steven Way and Stevens Drive, Timber Trail, White Pine Way.
- (5) The Town has reduced speed limits where the Town has determined that higher speed limits are unreasonable, unsafe and imprudent.

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2.30 Speed Restrictions. No person shall operate a motor vehicle in excess of the speed limits set forth in section 2.20 of this chapter. The provisions of this chapter shall be enforced by the law enforcement officers of Sauk County or any law officers dully qualified for law enforcement.

2.40 Weight Restrictions. Pursuant to section 349.16, Wis. Stats., the following seasonal or special weight limits shall be effective on the following Town of Spring Green Town highways, which are declared to be Class “B” highways under s. 349.15(2), Wis. Stats.:

No person shall operate a vehicle in excess of 8 tons on Big Hollow,
Rainbow Road and Prairie View.

No person may operate any vehicle on the above-noted highways, in violation of the above- noted weight limits, without a written permit issued by the Town Board of the Town of Spring Green. Any violation shall be subject to penalties under s. 348.21, Wis. Stats.

2.50 Damage to Town Roads and Bridges. In addition to any other remedy provided by law, any person or entity that damages a Town Road, right-of-way, or bridge is liable to the Town for the cost of repairing or replacing the same.
