Dear Board Members,

I have been monitoring groundwater elevations in four of six monitoring wells in the town of Spring Green. These were monitored previously by consultants, the Montgomery Associates firm. Depth to groundwater measurements on two dates are reported below. As is normally observed in Wisconsin, the water table is deeper in early summer compared to spring. Data loggers installed in these wells record elevations hourly. The hourly data is shown on the next page, and these data also show a slow decline in the elevation of the water table over this period.

I will continue to send you updates on water levels as we collect this information. The Wisconsin Geological and Natural History Survey is part of UW Extension. I am providing our equipment and time to monitor these wells at no cost to the Town. I have an on-going interest in the hydrogeology of the area. I also would like to increase my understanding of the conditions that caused extreme, high water table elevations in the summer of 2008.
