

**TOWN OF SPRING GREEN
REGULAR MEETING OCTOBER 4, 2007**

The regular meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm by Chairman Benny Stenner and was posted according to law. Members present were Chairman Benny Stenner, Supervisors Irv Snyder and Jerry Schmidt, Clerk James Blau and Treasurer Anita Bindl. Also present were 18 other residents.

Motion to approve the agenda by Irv & seconded by Jerry. M/C.

The minutes from the previous meeting were read and a motion to approve the minutes as read was made by Jerry and seconded by Irv. M/C.

Treasurers report by Anita Bindl starting balance of \$ 161,706.98 with receipts of \$ 3,841.27 and disbursements of \$ 18,842.95 leaving a balance of \$ 146,705.30. Motion to approve the report by Irv and seconded by Jerry. M/C.

Motion to approve and pay the monthly bills by Jerry and seconded by Benny. M/C.

Patrolman's report was given by Benny in the absence of Brad, Brad has been doing patching, trimming and cutting trees, and has been doing the third and last mowing. Brad also did regular maintenance on the equipment. Crack filling will be done this Friday Oct 5.

Building inspectors report by Tracy Johnson from Vierbicher & Ass. Very slow as only 1 ag permit and 2 out buildings.

Emergency Management report by Jerry, Jerry attended a meeting on Sept. 27 in Baraboo on damage assessment. Jerry also met with FEMA on the damage on Paulus Rd. From the storm and reported that the Town will be given money for the damage to repair the road and culvert. Jerry also stated that in the event of an emergency schools should be the last place to house residents so as not to interrupt classes. Better places are large churches or Community Buildings. A full reports is attached.

Plan Commission report by Fred Iausly, at the last meeting the commission heard about sustainable living in the Rive Valley Area, they also worked on the Driveway and Land Division Ordinance.

Chairman's report by Benny, Benny stated that on Oct 12 the Spring Green Police and a local repair man will conduct a free car clinic to check on vehicle maintenance like anti freeze,oil and tire pressure. Benny also stated that he attended a TRIP Fund meeting on Sept.13 and will submit several plans for road work for next year to see if the Town can receive some money. Also three members of the board attended aWTA meeting in Mineral Point on Budget Planning, Benny also reminded residents of the clean sweep taking place Oct 5 & 6 at the old Sauk County Landfill.

Ed Weidner was present to give an update on the new Spring Green Fire District Building and discussion followed as to have some options on the building to reduce the cost by eliminating some frills. Also of concern was the operating budget for the new building. Ed also stated that the department uses GPS. Ed will go back to the Fire Board to discuss our concerns and report back on a monthly basis. Funding for the Towns share is still being looked into.

Pat Warner from the Wi. River Runners ATV Club was present to ask for permission to use part of County Line road as a route for the club. Pat stated that the club has 38 family memberships. After much discussion on notice, and liability for the Town a motion to table the request until we hear from the Village of Lone Rock as to their concerns for safety and other issues was made by Irv and seconded by Jerry. M/C,

Fred Iausly gave a report on the status of the Towns Web site, Fred has been setting up links to the County and the Chamber of Commerce, and will give a full report at the next meeting. Fred also told the board about getting a free computer from the County or buying one on a first come basis when they are available.

Road Maintenance report by Benny, He stated that the Big Hollow project would be held off until next year because of time. Benny will also put it on the TRIP program. Motion by Irv and seconded by Jerry to delay the project until next year. M/C.

Dog License fees will be correct as \$ 12 for unneutered male & female and \$ 6 for neutered males & females this is done by ordinance. Also a \$ 150.00 a year fee will be charged for the two RV Parks in the Township. This will also be in an ordinance. Motion to charge the fees by Irv and seconded by Jerry. M/C.

Benny stated that he will apply for the TRIP fund for Big Hollow Rd. and also Jones Rd. Benny will make the application.

The LUCA plan for the census was discussed and Fred Iausly will check with the County to see if they can help with the project.

Pineland Ass. report by Michelle Thomas, the Ass. painted the shelter and also three picnic tables at the Park. They suggested to move the rock and have mulch put around it.

Public Comments By Paul Pratt, He asked to be considered to be put on next months agenda.
