

**TOWN OF SPRING GREEN  
REGULAR MEETING JAN 4, 2007**

The regular monthly meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. By Chairman Benny Stenner and was posted according to law. Members present were Chairman Benny Stenner, Supervisors Irv Snyder and Jerry Schmidt, Clerk James Blau and Treasurer Anita Bindl. Also Present was Patrolman Brad Haas and 18 other residents.

Motion to approve the agenda by Irv and seconded by Jerry. M/C.

The minutes from previous meeting were read and a motion to approve the minutes as read by Benny and seconded by Jerry. M/C.

Treasurers report by Anita, starting balance of \$ 35,956.29 with receipts of \$ 2110.36 and disbursements of \$ 33,080.85 leaving a balance of \$ 4985.80 which is the year end balance. A motion to approve the report by Irv and seconded by Jerry. M/C.

Patrolman's report by Brad, he has done shouldering work because of the warm weather and has done brush cutting and chipping, also he has been shifting the ashes at the burn site. Brad also said that the new truck and plow will be in the first part of next week. Brad also did regular maintenance on the equipment.

Tracy Johnson the building inspector from Vierbicher was present and gave a report on new buildings and homes for the past year. There were 12 new homes in the town for 2006.

Emergency Management report by Jerry, there was no meeting in Dec.

Chairman's report by Benny, Benny and Brad went to Monroe to check on the new truck, and he attended the NIMS meetings to be certified. Benny also attended the Prairie Sanitary District meeting. Benny also asked about the possibility of setting up a clean up day for large appliances and other materials in the spring. Benny will contact Town & Country and check on what will be accepted and also the cost.

Plan Commission report by Mary Merlie, the commission had their meeting on Dec 12, and went over issues in the pineland about ag and single family zoning. Michael Thomas from the Pineland was also present at the meeting and told of their web site at [WWW.thePinelands.org](http://WWW.thePinelands.org) and stated that about 300 homes are represented in the Pinelands. Mary also stated that they discussed County Forest and Community Forest and the definitions of each. Mary also stated that they discussed the possibility of fees if someone wants a rezoning for their property.

The Prairie Sanitary District was the next item on the agenda, Benny had some suggestions and after some discussion Irv made a motion to have one Town Board member be on the Commission and the other two live in the district, and have the commission elect a chairman. The commission is to give a quarterly report to the Town Board. Motion was seconded by Benny. Irv Snyder will represent the Town and the other 2 members will be Gene Dischler and Jim Blau.

Next on the agenda was the Lone Rock Fire District, Benny stated that he talked to them and that they would drop the claim if we would reinstate the district. Benny said that the attorneys suggested that we finish the claim first and then reconsider reinstating the district.

Next on the agenda was the Lake Proposal from the County in the County Forest. After much discussion Mary Merlie suggested that a few members from the Board and the Plan Commission go to the County Parks meeting and get more info on the proposal.

Road Maintenance report by Benny, The new truck will be here next week and that Benny will call the WTA and put another ad in it with a picture. Benny will also get some flyers made and distribute them around the area and to contractors.

Irv Snyder read the changes the board made on the Outdoor Wood Burning Ordinance and that he will send it back to the Attorneys and have them look it over before a public hearing is held.

A Motion to adjourn the meeting was made by Benny and was seconded by Jerry.M/C.
