MONTHLY MEETING JANUARY 8, 2009

The monthly meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm by Chairman Benny Stenner and was posted according to law. Members present were Chairman Benny Stenner, Supervisors Irv Snyder and Jerry Schmidt, Clerk James Blau and Treasurer Anita Bindl. Also present were Patrolman Brad Haas and 18 other residents.

Motion by Irv and seconded by Jerry to approve the agenda. M/C.

The minutes from the previous meeting were read and a motion to approve the minutes as read was made by Jerry and seconded by Irv. M/C.

Treasurers report by Anita, starting balance of \$ 53,543.21 with receipt of \$ 64,319.03 and disbursements of \$ 108,332.97 leaving a balance of \$ \$ 9,529.27 which is the year end balance.

Motion by Jerry and seconded by Irv to approve the report. M/C.

Motion by Irv and seconded by Jerry to approve and pay the monthly bills and to check Vierbicher's contract before sending out the check. M/C.

Patrolman's report by Brad, December had several snow and ice storms and they have been plowing and sanding. Brad said they have used 468 yard of sand and salt and 7 ½ yards of salt so far. Brad also had truck trouble and did regular maintenance on the equipment.

Building inspectors report by Tracy Johnson, no new permits.

Emergency Management report by Jerry, no monthly meeting this month but Jerry received a E mail stating Sauk County Emergency Management still have help for the flooding victims for cleaning supplies and help for small home repairs.

Plan Commission report by Fred Iausly, Fred stated that ATC came to the meeting and asked for a land expansion at the Rainbow Road site, they will come with a CSM at a later date. The commission is still working on the Land Division Ordinance. Fred will be working on the Richland Road concerns about vacating alleys and roads.

Chairman's report by Benny, Benny stated that December was a busy month with several meetings with FEMA, Budget Hearing meeting, Drainage District meetings, Jewell and land owners meetings, Flood Control meeting with Jewell and residents, Open House at the new Fire Station, Benny and Brad also met with Lamers Bus and discussed roads and routes.

Benny also stated that the board will attend the annual WTA meeting in Mineral Point in February.

Benny also gave an update on the Sauk County Forest concerns and that another meeting will be held in mid February.

The Flood Control Study will have another meeting in mid February and Benny stated that he asked CDBG for \$10,000.00 to help fund the study but was denied because they have stated they will help with the Town's share of the buyout.

Old Business: Richland Road was discussed and the Plan Commission will contact residents and have a meeting with them to seek help with vacating alleys and roads.
