

**TOWN OF SPRING GREEN
REGULAR MEETING APRIL 5, 2007**

The regular meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. By Chairman Benny Stenner and was posted according to law. Members present were Chairman Benny Stenner, Supervisors Irv Snyder and Jerry Schmidt, Clerk James Blau and Treasurer Anita Bindl. Also present were Patrolman Brad Haas and 12 other residents.

Motion by Irv and seconded by Jerry to approve the agenda. M/C.

The minutes from the previous meeting were read and a correction of a date was made and a motion to approve the minutes as read by Jerry and seconded by Irv. M/C.

Treasurers report by Anita starting balance of \$ 265,621.68 and receipts of \$ 12,823.02 and disbursements of \$ 139,623.89 leaving a balance of \$ 138,820.81. Motion to approve the report by Irv and seconded by Jerry. M/C.

Motion to approve and pay the monthly bills by Irv and seconded by Jerry. M/C.

Patrolman's report by Brad, only one small snow storm and has been cutting brush and chipping. Brad also painted the hall and started picking trash and did regular maintenance of the equipment.

Emergency Management report by Jerry, He stated that he has received papers of contact persons and places in case of an emergency. The first place is the River Valley Middle School. Jerry also said that he will attend the ICS 300 plan course in May.

Plan Commission report by Mary Merlie, Mary reported that at the last meeting they discussed Forest planning, and Federal aid for the airport, Bill Hackl's request for a farm consolidation and Terry Shifflets request for a storage shed, Mary also met with Brian Zimmer and talks about rezoning in the Pinelands, Mary said that he would get back to her with a decision from Planning and Zoning by April 10.

Prairie Sanitary District Board is still working on understanding the workings of the district and will meet with the Spring Green Village in the near future to check on agreements with them.

Chairman's report by Benny, Benny stated that he issued a driveway permit for Terry Shifflet for storage sheds, and that he was asked about driveway permits for parcels of land next to the Town Hall and he told them it has to go to the ET Committee first. Benny also stated that the County would like to sell part of the County Forest property.

Outdoor Furnace Ordinance was next on the agenda, Irv made a motion to pass the Outdoor Furnace Ordinance # 24 into law as the changes were made as of the last meeting, Jerry seconded the motion. M/C. The clerk will publish the ordinance as a class 1 notice.

Next on the agenda was the Spring Green Fire District proposal for a new fire station.

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Nick Liegel was present to explain the new location and building. A motion by Benny and seconded by Jerry to go on record for the Town Of Spring Green to accept the new location and station.M/C.

Next on the agenda was the Chamber of Commerce request for financial help from the town for the Sesquicentennial Celebration to be held Labor Day weekend. The celebration will start June 2nd and will continue through Country Christmas. After discussion on amounts from the village and county James Blau made a motion and was seconded by Irv to donate \$ 2500.00 for the cause. The rest of the residents present agreed unanimously. M/C.

Also present was Scott Lancaster from the DNR to ask for help to clean up slash in the pineland after pine thinning in the pinelands. The DNR will furnish help loading slash and haul it to the burn site, Patrolman Brad will help haul on May 2. DNR will pay for fuel and pay towards the ash hauling from the site.The Pineland Ass. will call members to help bring some of the slash to the ditch for pickup before May 2. Motion by Benny and second by Irv to donate Brads time for May 2 hauling.M/C.

Next on the agenda was road maintenance; The Board will do a road tour on Thursday April 12 at 1:00 p.m. The board will discuss a sign for the handicapped person for a curve and knoll on Laudon Rd.

Chairman Benny then made a motion to hold another board meeting on Thursday April 12 at 7:00 p.m. to finish the rest of the agenda and to appoint new members on the Plan Commission. Motion was seconded by Jerry. M/C.

Motion to adjourn by Benny and was seconded by Irv. M/C.
