

**TOWN OF SPRING GREEN
ANNUAL MEETING April 10, 2007**

The Annual meeting for the Town Of Spring Green was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Chairman Benny Stenner and was posted according to law. Board members present were Chairman Benny Stenner , Supervisors Irv Snyder and Jerry Schmidt and Clerk James Blau. Also present were Patrolman Brad Haas and 13 other residents.

The clerk read the minutes from the last annual meeting and a motion to approve the minutes as read by Jerry and seconded by Irv. M/C.

The annual report was handed out and very little discussion followed except for one item of concern was the Sauk County Sheriff's receipt of \$ 3600.00. Motion to approve the annual report by Benny Stenner and was seconded by Ted Bindl. M/C. Bill Mertens asked if the Sauk County Sheriff would come down to a meeting and give a report as to how often they are in the area.

New business : Tim Zumm asked the board about looking into a Dark Sky Compliance in regards to dust to dawn lights shinning into the sky and other spot lights. He will look into some ordinances of other towns and report back. There was no other new business.

Old Business : Chairman Benny Stenner brought up from last years minutes the fact that the town is still considering selling their two parcels of land. Some discussion followed and some said that a fund should be started if they are sold and some asked why sell them. It was suggested that a need should be established first before selling. A vote was taken and 15 voted to go ahead and start the process of selling them and 2 voted against Fred Iausly and Bill Mertens.

Benny stated that the town sold the end loader and a new truck with a plow was purchased and the residents were pleased because the snow was plowed faster and also sanded at the same time.

Benny stated that the town will not post roads in the future unless they start to break up. Sauk County also does not post roads but ask haulers to use good judgment when hauling.

A motion to hold next years annual meeting on April 8, 2008 was made by Fred Iausly and was seconded by Bill Mertens. M/C.

Motion to adjourn by Fred Iausly and was seconded by Marita Weidner. M/C.
