

**TOWN OF SPRING GREEN  
REGULAR MEETING MAY 3, 2007**

The regular monthly meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm by Chairman Benny Stenner and was posted according to law. Members present were Chairman Benny Stenner, Supervisors Irv Snyder and Jerry Schmidt, Clerk James Blau and Treasurer Anita Bindl. also present were Patrolman Brad Haas and 11 other residents and Bud Thompson from Scott Const.and Craig Mitchell from Fahrner Asphalt.

Motion to approve the agenda by Jerry and seconded by Irv. M/C.

The minutes from the April 5 and April 12 meetings were read and a motion to approve the minutes as read by Jerry and seconded by Irv. M/C.

Treasurers report by Anita Bindl, starting balance of \$ 138,820.81 with receipts of \$ 98,352.48 and disbursements of \$ 83,510.25 leaving a balance of \$ 153,663.04. Motion to approve the report by Benny and seconded by Irv. M/C.

Motion to approve and pay the monthly bills by Irv and seconded by Jerry. M/C.

Patrolman's report by Brad, only 1 snow storm in April , Brad has been doing brush cutting, picking trash, cleaning up the Town park and did some landscaping out front. Brad also helped the DNR haul slash from the Pinelands to the burn site. Brad also did regular maintenance on the equipment.

Building inspectors report by Tracy Johnson, 1 new home permit plus 7 other small permits for remodeling. Tracy also stated that he has received several apps for permits on existing out door furnaces and that he will be setting up a spread sheet to record them.

Emergency Management report by Jerry Schmidt, Jerry attended meetings in Baraboo and they would like the town to purchase wrist bands for personnel working in disaster areas. Jerry will attend the ICS classes on June 7,13,20 and the 27 for training.

Plan Commission report by Fred Iausly, Fred stated that at the April meeting they had discussion on a open meeting request from Mike Birr but to date no records were requested. At the meeting they approved a request from Dave Liegel for a Ag building off Jones Rd. but was told He would have to go to the ET first to get their approval also. They also discussed the time table for rezoning in the Pinelands. The Town will hold a informational meeting June 26 and requested that the Zoning administrator be present and then its up to the County to hold a public hearing on the rezoning.

Regarding the Plan Commission, Benny appointed Brian Frank to the commission for a 2 year term. Motion to approve the appointment by Jerry and seconded by Irv. M/C.

Chairman's report by Benny, Benny stated that he attended several meetings regarding road tours, ET meeting and Lone Rock Fire District meeting.

Next on the agenda was the opening of road bids for road work in the Township.

First was seal coating bids, after much discussion Irv made a motion to award the bid to Scott Construction for a bid of \$ 10,388.00- per mile for single seal because Fahrner did not bid

according to specs sent out and was too hard to figure small sections of roads that need to be included. Jerry seconded by motion. M/C.

Next was the gravel bids, Bindl Bauer Limestone's bid was \$ 7.50 per ton of screened chips and Kraemers bid was \$ 11.60 per ton for washed chips. After some discussion Irv made a motion to award the bid to Bindl Bauer Limestone and was seconded by Jerry because Kraemers did not bid screened chips. and the Town decided to go with screened instead of washed because of the cost. M/C.

Next was bids for Crack Filling, again Crack Filling of Cross Plains did not bid according to specs and Jerry made a motion to award the bid to TAZ for a total of \$ 6736.80 if all the work is approved and was seconded by Irv. M/C.

Big Hollow road was also discussed and to remove 2 feet from the knoll and widen the road and seal coat and have Bill Meise do the work for a cost of about \$ 13,000.00 plus gravel and chips. Motion by Irv and seconded by Jerry to approve the work and then post the road to 8 ton weight limit.

The town's assessor Michael Rogers was present to set up the Open Book and Board of Review. Open Book is set for Monday June 25, 2007 from 6:00 pm to 8:00 pm. The Board of Review is set for Wednesday July 11, 2007 from 5:00 pm to 7:00 pm.

Milton Sprecher was present to question the assessor about right of ways along Hwy 14 from County Line Road to the bridge. After much discussion about easements from the state Michael Rogers and several other residents met to go over details.

Chairman Benny stated that the WTA is holding a workshop for town officials both new and old and that some of the board will be attending a meeting on May 18 in Richland Center.

Motion to Adjourn by Irv and seconded by Jerry. M/C.
