

**TOWN OF SPRING GREEN
REGULAR MEETING JUNE 7, 2007**

The regular monthly meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Chairman Benny Stenner and was posted according to law. Members present were Chairman Benny Stenner, Supervisors Irv Snyder and Jerry Schmidt, and Treasurer Anita Bindl. Absent was Clerk James Blau. Also present were Patrolman Brad Haas, Fred Iausly, Bill Mertens, Michelle Thomas, Andy and Barb Ringelstetter, Dave Radel and Mike Birr.

Motion to approve the agenda by Irv and seconded by Jerry. M/C.

Minutes from previous meeting were read by Anita Bindl in the absence of the clerk and a motion to approve the minutes as read by Jerry and seconded by Benny. M/C.

Treasurers report by Anita starting balance of \$ 153662.99 with receipts of \$ 5884.31 and disbursements of \$ 21,946.95 leaving a balance of \$ 137,600.35. Motion to approve the report by Irv and seconded by Jerry. M/C.

Motion to approve and pay monthly bills by Irv and seconded by Jerry. M/C.

Patrolman's report by Brad Haas, Brad has been trash picking, mowing, patching and did regular maintenance on equipment. Brad also reported that seal coating has started and has been cutting brush and trees for the Richland Street project. Brad also said that the fire extinguishers have all been updated.

Building Inspectors report : Tracy Johnson was not present, but reported that 4 new permits were issued and that 12 permits for outdoor furnaces have been issued.

Emergency Management report by Jerry Schmidt, May 24 meeting, items discussed were shelter and food is now in the hands of the Red Cross, and second is the Salvation Army. A list of storm shelters is on the Sauk County web site www.co.sauk.wi.us. ICS training was canceled due to lack of members. Next meeting will be in June and may go to every other month.

Plan Commission report by Fred Iausly: May 8 meeting ,2 issues for Dale Pforr to rezone some acres to residential. June 5 meeting Marc Cupp will be present to address the Hwy. 60 Scenic Riverway. Also on the June agenda will be a building for Northern Natural Gas Co. for a pump on the Andy & Barb Ringelstetter property. The Commission also discussed amending the Comprehensive plan. Next meeting is July 11.

Chairman's report by Benny: Benny stated that 4 board members attended the WTA mtg. at Hillpoint and that 3 board members attended the WTA meeting in Richland Center . Benny also stated that he has received a request for a sidewalk into the Village. He also discussed a special assessment for septic systems, and told the board that a Clean Sweep by the County will take place in September. Benny also stated that the Zoning appeal in the village to include town board members.

The Board of Review was opened by a motion by Irv and seconded by Jerry. M/C. Then a motion to close the Board of Review until the assessor has completed his work was made by Benny and seconded by Irv. M/C. Board of Review is set for July 11, 2007 from 5:00 to 7:00 p.m.

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The 2007 Liquor licenses were read and a motion to approve them by Irv and seconded by Jerry. M/C. Liquor licenses for renewal were Rite Way plaza Class A Beer, Spring green Rod & Gun Club Class B Beer, River Valley Oil Class A Beer, Woody's LLC Class A Beer and Class A Liquor, Newtons Sales & Service Class A Beer, Bob's Riverside Class B Beer & Class B Liquor, Round Barn Class b Beer & Class B Liquor, and The New Arthurs Class B Beer. & Class B Liquor.

Next item on the agenda was Road Maintenance program for Big Hollow Rd. project, Bids for base gravel and gravel came from Bindl Bauer Limestone and Kraemer Co. Bids were Bindl Bauer \$ 6.29 a yd and 6.49 a yd. and The Kraemer Co. was \$ 7.45 a yd. Motion to award the bid to Bindl Bauer Limestone by Irv and seconded by Jerry M/C.

Bridge Maintenance was discussed.

Rezoning for Dale Pforr 1. Move driveways north 2. 66 wide deeded area for drive # 4 3. 20 yr. deed restrictions on 8 lots 4. All driveway accesses before sale. Motion to accept Pforr's rezoning by Jerry and seconded by Irv. M/C. Also rezoning was suspect for the Northern Natural Gas Co. proposal for a Propane pressure station , Structure to be sound proofed and trees planted on the east and south sides open to the north and west. also dark sky lighting , and sound not to exceed 54 decibels. Motion by Benny and seconded by Jerry. M/C.

Town rezoning in part of the Pinelands was discussed and a letter will be sent to all owners of affected parcels. A public Mtg. is set for Tuesday June 26, 2007. There are 235 parcels affected by the rezoning from ag to residential. Motion to approve the rezone by Irv and seconded by Jerry M/C.

Pineland Summer project : residents would like to donate a truck load of sand for the Park.

Town's Insurance was next on the agenda , Rural Ins. Agent Dave Zwettler was present to discuss the 3 proposed increases . A motion to accept the increase by Irv and seconded by Benny. M/C.

Additional meetings will start in August and will consist of reviewing ordinances and decide from there to have additional meetings as needed. Motion to approve additional meetings by Irv and seconded by Jerry.
