

**TOWN OF SPRING GREEN
REGULAR MEETING SEPTEMBER 6, 2007**

The regular monthly meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. By Chairman Benny Stenner and was posted according to law. Members present were Chairman Benny Stenner, Supervisors Irv Snyder and Jerry Schmidt, Clerk James Blau and Treasurer Anita Bindl. Also present were Patrolman Brad Haas and 12 other residents.

Motion by Jerry and seconded by Irv to approve the agenda. M/C.

The minutes from previous meeting were read and a motion to approve the minutes as read was made by Jerry and seconded by Benny. M/C.

Treasurers report by Anita starting balance of \$ 331,973.87 with receipts of \$ 63,817.81 and disbursements of \$ 234,084.70 leaving a balance of \$ 161,706.98. Motion to approve the report by Irv and seconded by Jerry. M/C.

Motion by Irv and seconded by Jerry to approve and pay the monthly bills. M/C.

Patrolman's report by Brad, he has finished the second mowing and started the third and last mowing, put up signs after vandals pushed them over, fixed wash out on Paulus road after the storm, took care of the park and did maintenance on equipment.

Building Inspectors report, Tracy was not present to report 1 new house permit.

Emergency Management report by Jerry, there was no meeting in August but Fema sent e mails to him asking to report and storm damage in the area. Jerry also will have Brad do his Nims 100 certification.

Plan Commission report by Fred Iausly, slow month only approved a CSM for Lee Phillips to combine two lots to allow him to build a 30 by 60 building for furniture shop.

Chairman's report by Benny, he attended an ET meeting with the village Aug 15, and WTA meeting at Ironton on Aug 16, special meeting with the Towns attorney to go over existing ordinances, Fire district meeting Aug 21 to hear plans for new fire station, Public hearing at Baraboo for rezoning. Benny also stated that several board members will attend a WTA session on budgets in Mineral Point Sept. 17 and he will attend a Trip fund meeting in Baraboo on Sept. 13. Benny also talked about getting a outside bulletin board to put notices in.

The first agenda item was the CSM for Lee Phillips, after discussion the board voted to approve the CSM

Motion by Jerry to approve the CSM and seconded by Benny with Irv having reservations because it is in a residential district.

Next on the agenda was the Spring Green Fire District's proposed new building and how the town will finance its share. Discussion followed as to have the Town borrow the full amount and save interest of to borrow for a few years at a time so as not to jeprodize the towns levy. The matter will be on next months agenda. Several residents from the west end of the township had concerns about the time it took SG fire Dept. To

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respond to calls and not knowing where some of the residents lived. Benny told them the board would talk to the Fire Chief and report back at the next meeting.

The Outdoor Furnace Ordinance will be brought up at the meeting next Monday Sept 10 with the Towns Attorney when we go over some of the ordinances.

Town's Web site is moving along slowly and that Fred Iausly is starting to add minutes and agendas to it. Fred also asked for help to get the info page started. After some discussion on a computer for the town hall and Internet access a motion by Irv and seconded by Jerry to have Fred Iausly and Michele Thomas look into getting a used one from either the County or the State.M/C. Internet access will be checked into after we buy a computer.

The towns road project on Big Hollow Rd will be started in about 1-2 weeks by Bill Meise. Benny will check with him and Scott Construction as to time table.

A meeting is set for Sept 10 with the towns attorney to go over old ordinances and add new ones as needed.

Next on the agenda was a new computer program for the towns records. After some discussion and review of two programs a motion by Irv and seconded by Jerry to go with Winstar-Win program from Marilyn K.Bhend. M/C.

Budget planning meeting was tentatively set for Oct 11, at 6:00 pm and a budget hearing was tentatively set for Nov 15 at 7:00 pm.

New sign placement was discussed for a turtle crossing sign on Kennedy Road.After some discussion a motion to approve the signs was made by Jerry and seconded by Irv to have the Pineland Ass. Pay for the signs and posts. M/C.

The Pineland Ass will paint the shelter at the park this Saturday Sept 8.
