

**TOWN OF SPRING GREEN  
REGULAR MEETING AUGUST 2, 2007**

The regular monthly meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. By Chairman Benny Stenner and was posted according to law. Members present were Chairman Benny Stenner, Supervisors Irv Snyder and Jerry Schmidt, Clerk James Blau, and Treasurer Anita Bindl. Also present were Patrolman Brad Haas and 10 other residents.

Motion to approve the agenda by Irv and seconded by Jerry . M/C.

The minutes from the previous meeting were read and a motion to approve the minutes as read by Jerry and seconded by Irv. M/C.

Treasurers report by Anita, starting balance of \$ 132,386.03 with receipts of \$ 256,825.74 and disbursements of \$ 57,237.90 leaving a balance of \$ 331,973.87. Motion to approve the report by Irv and seconded by Benny. M/C.

Motion to approve and pay the monthly bills and to hold Bindl Bauer Limestone until the amount is checked out by Benny motion by Irv and seconded by Jerry. M/C.

Patrolman's report by Brad Haas, Brad has been mowing and patching taking care of the park and pressure washed the front of the building. Brad took one weeks vacation in July, he also did regular maintenance of the equipment.

Building inspectors report by Tracy Johnson from Vierbecher and Ass., 3 new homes and several outbuildings.

Emergency Management report by Jerry Schmidt, Jerry told of the NIMS compliance report, Clean Sweep on Oct. 5 & 6, Damage Assessment, Pass system, and pandemic exercise. Attached is the full report.

Plan Commission report by Fred Iausly, meeting on July 11 they reviewed letters of concern for rezoning, and the commission told the board that they support the rezoning and that it goes along with the Comprehensive Plan, they also heard presentation by Marc Cupp on Scenic Byway and that the commission recommends the Town support the Scenic Byway. They also reviewed the Steve & Connie Millers request to divide their property and sell off 6.4 acres. Also Tom Labudde request to divide 2 parcels off his property.

Chairman's report by Benny, he reported that Clean Sweep for the County will be held on Oct. 5 & 6 at the old landfill off hwy. 33 in Reedsburg. Also Board of Review was held on July 11 and there was no one to complain on their assessments. WTA quarterly meeting will be held on Aug. 16 in the Town of Ironton.

Marc Cupp of the Wi.Scenic Byway project gave a presentation on the project and told that the only new restriction was no new outdoor billboards will be allowed. A motion by Benny and seconded by Jerry to go on record that the Town supports the Scenic Byway. M/C.

Jerry Schmidt asked the board to sign the NIMS Compliance Certificate and send to the County.

Another item on the agenda was the Steve & Connie Millers land division and CAM. Motion by Irv and seconded Benny to approve the CAM. M/C.

Next was the outdoor furnace ordinance and that one resident failed to comply with it even after he received a letter. Motion by Benny and seconded by Jerry to serve papers and a fine on Mark Berg for non compliance of the ordinance.

Benny stated that the board had a meeting with the village on the concerns of the burn site, it was suggested to charge contractors \$ 75 for a truck load. Also a fence was proposed to be installed around the site and paint the existing fence. The board and village will meet at a later date on the matter.

The resolution to rezone will be held at the County on August 28 in Baraboo and a motion by Irv and seconded by Jerry to recommend and approve the rezoning because it goes with the goals and projections of the Comprehensive Plan. M/C.

Fred Iausly has been working on the Towns Web site and asked if anyone would like to help and if they had any pictures to add.

Road Maintenance projections were discussed and the bridge work has been completed by Wilson Creek Excavating and that Bill Meise will start on the Big Hollow road sometime in August.

Benny asked the board to set a meeting to go over the towns ordinances and possibly add new ones with the help of the Towns attorney Nattalie. Meeting will be held either August 21 or 22 if OK or else the 27.

Pineland Association will paint the shelter at the Park next month.

Motion to adjourn and go into closed session for patrolman compensation by Benny and seconded by Jerry. M/C.

Motion to reconvene into regular session by Jerry and seconded by Irv. M/C.

Public comments by John McKenna, John stated that the Town should do more for the high nitrates in the township and he has read reports that in the area there is a high number of cancer cases. He also stated that the tree roots filter out the nitrates and the town should limit building and removing trees.

Motion to adjourn by Irv and seconded by Jerry. M/C.
