

TOWN OF SPRING GREEN REGULAR MEETING APRIL 3, 2008

The regular meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm by Chairman Benny Stenner and was posted according to law. Members present were Chairman Benny Stenner, Supervisor Jerry Schmidt Irv Snyder was absent, Clerk James Blau and Treasurer Anita Bindl. Also present were Patrolman Brad Haas and 13 other residents.

Motion by Jerry and seconded by Benny to adopt the agenda. M/C.

The minutes from the previous meeting were read and a motion to approve the minutes with the correction of Brad Hutnick instead of Mark Cupp to do the walk through the County Forest on April 26 was made by Jerry and seconded by Benny. M/C.

Treasurers report by Anita Bindl, starting balance of \$ 201,555.07 with receipts of \$ 61,824.27 and disbursements of \$ 71,158.42 leaving a balance of \$ 192,220.92. Motion to approve the report by Jerry and seconded by Benny. M/C.

Motion to approve and pay the monthly bills by Benny and seconded by Jerry. M/C.

Patrolman's report by Brad, during March there were several small snow storms and he put up signs and took truck to Monroe to have warranty work done, Brad also started to pick trash and will start trimming trees and chipping. Brad also did maintenance on the equipment.

No report from the Building Inspector. Also no permits were issued.

Emergency Management report by Jerry, he attended a meeting in Baraboo and stated that the DNR is available to help in case of an emergency with water quality and other wind damage. The full report is attached.

Plan Commission report by Michelle Thomas, they have been working on a rezone for a parcel off Leone Road with the ETZ address is S 5307 and is owned by William and Lisa Falcon. They also have been working on the Land Division Ordinance. Next meeting is set for April 15.

Chairman's report by Benny, Benny and the Board attended the WTA meeting in Mineral Point for the annual meeting, the main topic was the Board of Review Training. Benny and Brad attended a meeting with the Bus Company and Benny also had meetings with Planning & Zoning, ETZ over the rezone for Cardinal, Fire Dept. Meetings and Ordinance meeting. Mike Birr and Herman Kaldenburg asked about the Driveway Ordinance and suggested to have a meeting to get input from residents and not just from the board.

Spring Green Fire district report was given by Benny, he stated that the bids came in just under budget of 2.4 million the low bid was 2.25 million which included the building and the land. The Fire District has a loan with Rural Development for 40 years with interest at 4.375%.

The Plan Commission needs to have a new member because Joni Graves resigned. Benny appointed Jeff Heintz for a 2 year term and Fred Iausly for a 2 year term as Chairman, Motion by Jerry and seconded by Benny to approve the appointment. M/C.

Road Maintenance, Benny stated that the board needs to have signs made to post some of the towns road as Class B roads. The Town also has to post the bridge on Wilson Creek Road for a weight limit of 40 tons according to the state statute.

The Boards Spring Road tour to check on the roads will be held on April 8 at 8:00 am. The Trip money to repair Big Hollow Road has been awarded for 2008 and will be done early this spring.

Building repairs for the Town Hall will be done by Design Structures at a cost of \$ 2850.00 Insurance will pay for it except for \$500 deductible. Also the Laudon Park shelter will be rebuilt after the old one is removed the insurance already paid \$5000.00. Benny will get bids to replace it. Benny had 2 bids to tear down the old shelter from Mark Alt for \$ 250 and one from Jr. Mueller for \$ 1000.00. Motion by Jerry to have Mark Alt do the work and was seconded by Benny. M/C.

The Safe Routes to School program was discussed and Benny had a letter for the group stating that the Town supports the plan.

The CSM for rezoning the parcel off Leone Road was presented for owners William & Lisa Falcon and was approved for rezoning from recreational to R4 ETZ single family. Motion by Jerry and was seconded by Benny. M/C.

The LUCA census program is put on hold until the County has more information. Tim Zum was not present for the outdoor lighting ordinance that he favors. He will report later.

Pineland report by Michelle Thomas, she stated that they will do a county forest clean up on April 26 starting at 9:30.

No Old Business

Public Comments Dave Radel stated that the Tower off Thuli Road has the strobe lights not working and he has a safety issue with it. Benny stated that it is up to the county and that Jerry will call the county to have them repaired.

Motion to Adjourn by Benny and seconded by Jerry. M/C.
