

TOWN OF SPRING GREEN ANNUAL MEETING APRIL 8, 2008

The annual meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm by Chairman Benny Stenner and was posted according to law. Members present were Chairman Benny Stenner, Supervisors Irv Snyder and Jerry Schmidt, Clerk James Blau and Treasurer Anita Bindl. Also present were 22 other residents.

The minutes from last years meeting were read and a motion to approve the minutes as read was made by Jerry and was seconded by Marita Weidner. M/C.

The annual financial report was handed out and several questions were asked about the legal fees, fire district fees, and DNR payments. After some discussion a motion was made by Irv Snyder and seconded by Bill Mertens to approve the report. M/C.

Under New Business: Kolby Hirth brought up the rezoning of property for the Cardinal Plant, Kolby asked the board if there was anything they could do to make sure that the berms were going to be installed as promised. Irv told her that the board will stay in touch with the Village and Cardinal to try to help with the berm and also light pollution concerns. Kolby thanked the board for their help with the concerns of the resident near the site of the new plant.

Benny Stenner brought up one concern from last years meeting for the sale of the Towns two parcels of land. The one parcel is on Donald Road and the other is on High Banks. After some discussion on why the Town should sell them, it was to sell the parcels and put the money in a trust to make improvements at Laudon Park. Motion by Kolby Hirth and seconded by Patty Brooks to have the board consider selling the parcels. A vote was taken and 16 were for and 6 against. M/C. Benny stated that a driveway issue has to be resolved first.

Benny Stenner thanked the patrolman Brad Haas and Gary Mueller for the work they did this past year for the good job of plowing snow. It was a terrible winter with a record amount of snow 112 inches. Several other residents also thanked the patrolman for his work.

Irv Snyder brought up the Fire Districts new building and how the Town is going to pay its share.

Benny brought up an issue from last year about the sale of the Towns 2 lots one off Donald Road and the other at Beau Riverain. An appraisal will be done on both lots. Benny stated that the sale of the lots was voted on at the last annual meeting by a majority of the residents present. Money from the sale of the lot or lots would be used to increase Laudon Park.

Tim Zumm brought up the Dark Sky Compliance in regards to dust to dawn lights shinning into the sky and other spot lights. Tim will look into some ordinances of other towns and report back. Snow plowing and road work was also talked about due to the heavy snows.

A motion to hold next years annual meeting on Tuesday April 14, 2009 was made by Fred Iausly and seconded by Bill Mertens. M/C.
